The **Satchmo Art Show** will take place at the Crescent City Brewhouse for the month of August 2008. The show will be juried and offer cash prizes, work will hang for one month and will be for sale. Judges are from the community and an Artist reception will be scheduled.

The show theme will be Jazz music and the life and times of Louis “SATCHMO” Armstrong.

Submissions must be posted or e-mailed by July 18th, 2008.

Since our time line is short and we have not mounted this show in 2 years; we will admit work that has been completed in the past 18 months but not entered in any local show. Work must be ready to hang (wire/hooks). Artwork must measure 16"x20" unframed or larger. Entries in all media except photography will be considered. All work must be for sale, any other work needs committee approval to hang but cannot be judged. All work must be picked up at close of show on September 2nd from the Brewhouse. Work not claimed will be assessed a \$25 storage fee.

- An entry fee of \$15 will be charged on each work accepted.
- Fees are due at time of delivery.
- Artist will be notified of acceptance via e-mail or phone and delivery times will be set up.
- Cash prizes totaling \$1,000 will be awarded at the Artists Reception, which will take place at Crescent City Brewhouse July 30, 2008 ,5 p.m. until 7 p.m.
- All artists are asked to attend and bring your friends and family.
- Refreshments will be served.

Celebrate Satchmo SummerFest 2008 and take part in **FQN&S Satchmo Art Show** back at the Brewhouse.
